- 1. Vina Nerea Blanco (House dry white), La Mancha, Spain.** £4.50 £6.00 £18.00
Fresh, light and fruity dry white from the sun drenched vineyards of central Spain.
- 2. Capriano Tai, Pinot Grigio, Italy.** £4.75 £6.50 £19.00
A delightful Pinot Grigio from northern Italy showing good fruit character with a light floral finish.
- 3. Marcel Martin Chardonnay, France.** £5.00 £6.70 £20.00
Lovely rounded melon and peach flavours on the palate with a hint of butter giving a richer palate.
- 4. Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine St Louis, France.** £6.00 £8.60 £26.00
Known as the "Chablis of the South", the wines of Picpoul de Pinet are un-oaked, crisp, refreshing and great with fish.
- 5. Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, Honu, New Zealand.** £6.00 £ 8.00 £24.00
From the eastern tip of the south Island of New Zealand this delicious Marlborough Sauvignon has luscious flavours of gooseberry, nettle and passion fruit. Crisp and mouth filling with a lovely flinty finish.
- 6. Cofrade Rioja Blanco, Spain.** £23.00
A fresh modern style. Pale lemon in colour with zesty aromas and notes of green apple, peach and pineapple. Bright acidity on the palate and a refreshing finish.
- 7. Zensa Organic Fiano, Italy.** £27.00
Deliciously crisp with green apple and grapefruit character, the organic Fiano grapes are hand harvested to ensure optimum ripeness. A little lees aging helps add subtle weight to the palate bringing about sweeter tropical flavours of mango and peach.
- 8. Gewürztraminer Villa Wolf, Germany.** £28.00
Spicy, rose petal aromas and a lovely textured palate. Plenty of fresh stone fruit and delicate lychee flavours. Medium dry.
- 9. Sancerre 'La Merisiere' Jean Pabiot, France.** £35.00
A seductive and complex dry white wine from the flinty terroir of the Loire. The family have been making wine here for three centuries and this wine shows just how good Sancerre can be.
- 10. Chablis 1er Cru, Vau de Vey, Domaine de Malandes. France.** £38.00
45 year old vines go to make a highly concentrated wine, with flavours of apple and a hint of apricot. Chablis at its very best.
- 11. Rully 1er cru Vincent Giardin, France.** £42.00
Rully is a beautifully small appellation within Burgundy that produces wonderfully complex whites with zesty, peachy fruit and nutty, buttery overtones.

Red Wine

12. Rio Lento Merlot, Chile.

£4.00 £6.00 £18.00

Soft and juicy Merlot from grapes grown within Chile's central valley. Blackcurrant and blackberry fruit flavours in abundance.

13. Camina Tempranillo, La Mancha, Spain.

£4.50 £6.40 £19.00

Crunchy red berry aromas of raspberry, cherry and blackberry. Wonderfully smooth on the palate.

14. Los Gansos Pinot Noir, Chile.

£6.00 £8.00 £21.00

The Los Gansos winery employs ducks to help keep down the local native snail population! Light and fruity Pinot noir with very little in the way of tannin.

15. Victoria Park Shiraz – Viognier, Australia.

£6.25 £8.00 £24.00

The first aromas are blackcurrant, red cherry and subtle spice, then follows subtle apricot from the white Viognier grape. The two balance beautifully giving a silky glass of plump Shiraz.

16. El Tesoro Malbec, Argentina.

£6.00 £8.00 £24.00

Dark plum and blackcurrant flavours with slight spice, full bodied by nature. Warming, sumptuous and rewarding wine.

17. Rioja Arjona, Bodegas Navajas, Spain.

£24.00

Silky cherry and raspberry fruit flavours with just a hint of vanilla. A classic Rioja from a great Bodega.

18. Chateau Moulin de Mallet, Bordeaux France.

£27.00

Chateau Moulin de Mallet has been in the ownership of the same Bordeaux family since 1898. Renowned for producing Claret so typical of the region, this beautiful wine is full of ripe blackberry, smoke and earthy flavours. Full bodied and with a long finish.

19. Zensa Organic Primitivo, Italy.

£29.00

This sumptuous Primitivo undergoes 'appassimento' where the organic grapes are air dried for several weeks to increase intensity of flavour before being pressed. The result is a wine bursting with bright morello cherry and deep blackcurrant flavours. Subtle, sweet spice and vanilla leads to a very satisfying finish.

20. Gougenheim Malbec Reserva, Argentina.

£32.00

Proper full bodied Malbec and a perfect match for steak. Plush and sumptuous with fleshy black fruit flavours followed by notes of roasted coffee, smoke and toast.

21. Chateau Lafon, Lustrac-Medoc Bordeaux France.

£38.00

Chateau Lafon is a powerful wine with lively dark fruits on the palate coupled with more mellow notes of savoury, spice and the classic cigar box flavours expected from a good Bordeaux. Ripe tannins give this wine plenty of structure and a long finish. Lustrac-Medoc is situated very close to the Margaux appellation.

22. Gevrey Chambertin, Rene Bouvier. Burgundy, France.

£54.00

40 year old vines, low yields and a total abstinence from chemical sprays produces top quality fruit, aged in French oak for 18 months resulting in a wine of purity, power and elegance.

Rosé Wine

23. Alverdi Pinot Grigio Blush Rosé, Italy. £5.25 £7.00 £21.00

Beautifully delicate, this Italian rosé is the perfect thing for a sunny day. Raspberry and strawberry flavours mingle to produce a soft and dry style of rosé that is almost too easy to drink.

24. Sungate White Zinfandel Rosé, USA. £5.50 £7.40 £22.00

Full flavoured rosé from the sweetly fruited but confusingly named White Zinfandel grape. Intense strawberry and candyfloss flavours are the hallmarks here.

25. Pasquiers Grenache - Cinsault Rosé, France. £25.00

A Provencale style rosé; light in colour with a raspberry infused palate and a touch of peach, a dry and refreshing finish that's just perfect for a sunny afternoon.

Sparkling and Champagne

26. Prosecco 'ITA', Treviso Italy. £5.00 £25.00

An aromatic Prosecco, full of fresh grape, pear and honeysuckle aromas. True Prosecco character on the palate with citrus and further fresh grape. Delicate bubbles with a satisfying finish.

27. Vetricano Sparkling Rosato £5.00 £25.00

Crushed raspberry and strawberry with a hint of peach, light and refreshing this delicious sparkling rose is a true taste of Italian sunshine right here in Chipping Norton!

28. Baron de Beaupre Brut Champagne NV £7.00 £39.00

A decadent Champagne with aromas of peach, apricot and brioche. The palate is exceptionally smooth with excellent finesse, the blend weighs heavily in favour of the Pinot Meunier grape, making it a rich & fruity style.

29. Nyetimber Classic Cuvée, West Sussex, England. £50.00

Consistently beating some of the finest Champagnes in blind tastings, Nyetimber is a wonderfully rich and intense English sparkling wine, with aromas of blossom, apple and brioche.

30. Laurent Perrier Rosé NV, France. £75.00

First made in 1968 the Cuvée Rosé Murphys Shiraz Brut is made entirely from Pinot Noir. The juice is left in contact with the red grape skins for just a short time to give a salmon pink colour. This process, known as the saignee method, is rare in Champagne and one of the main reasons for the wine's superior quality.

31. Bollinger Grand Annee Vintage 2005, France. £100.00

This cuvee is entirely vinified in small oak barrels in which oxidation can be carefully controlled to guarantee an excellent ageing capacity. Simply one of the finest Champagnes in existence.

33. Chateau Septy Monbazillac, France. £5.90 £22.00

Honied in colour with ripe flavours of peach, raisin and honey. Chateau Septy have been making this delicious pudding wine for generations right in the heart of Monbazillac near Bergerac.

A classic LBV style from the fabulous Taylors estate. Rich, red fruit; sweet and sticky, the perfect way to end a good night.
